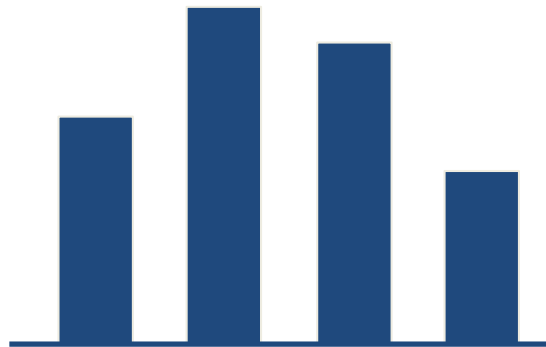

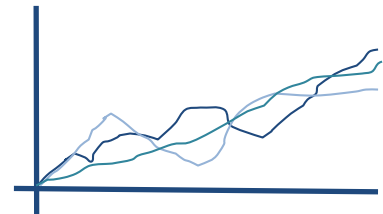
Business intelligence takes your data, uses proven methodologies to analyze and interpret it, and provides you with **useful information for more effective, data-driven decision making.**
